

Parallels between Jeroboam and Moses

David incorporates "Israel" into his reign	Pharaoh 1 incorporates "Israel" into his reign
Solomon enslaves Israelites for his building projects	Pharaoh 2 enslaves Israelites for his building projects
Jeroboam is associated with Solomon	Moses is associated with pharaoh 2
When Solomon seeks to kill him, Jeroboam escapes to Egypt	When Pharaoh 2 seeks to kill him, Moses escapes to Midian
After Solomon's death, Jeroboam returns to confront the new king (Rehoboam) over royal harshness	After Pharaoh 2's death, Moses returns to confront the new king (Pharaoh 3) over royal harshness
Jeroboam leads Israel in rebellion against Rehoboam	Moses leads Israel in rebellion against Pharaoh 3
YHWH tells Rehoboam to stop chasing the Israelites	YHWH sends "plagues" on Egypt so they will stop chasing the Israelites
Jeroboam proposes a religion with YHWH's presence throughout the land	Moses proposes a religion with YHWH's presence in the wilderness
Jeroboam's sons are Nadab and Abijah	Aaron's (Moses' brother) sons are Nadab and Abihu
