1 KINGS 2.2-4	DEUTERONOMY/JOSHUA
I am about to go the way of all the earth.	<b>J23.14:</b> And now I am about to go the way of all the earth.
and <b>keep the charge of YHWH your God</b>	<b>D11.1:</b> You shall love <b>YHWH your God</b> , therefore, and <b>keep his charge</b>
walking in his ways and keeping his statutes, his <b>commandments</b> , his ordinances, and his testimonies	<b>D8.6:</b> Therefore <b>keep the commandments</b> of YHWH your God, by <b>walking in his ways</b> <b>D11.22:</b> you will diligently <b>observe this entire commandment</b> that I am commanding you, loving YHWH your God, <b>walking in all his ways</b> , <b>D30.16:</b> <b>walking in his ways</b> , and <b>observing his commandments</b> , decrees, and ordinances,
as it is written in the law of Moses	<b>J8.31:</b> just as Moses the servant of YHWH had commanded the Israelites, <b>as it is written in the book of the law of Moses</b> <b>J23.6:</b> Therefore be very steadfast to observe and do <b>all that is written in the book of the law of Moses</b> , turning aside from it neither to the right nor to the left,
so that you may succeed in all that you do and wherever you turn.	<b>D29.9:</b> Therefore diligently observe the words of this covenant, <b>in order that you may succeed in everything that you do.</b>
Then YHWH will establish his word that he spoke concerning me: 'If your sons take heed to their way, to walk before me in faithfulness <b>with all their heart and with all their being</b> , there shall not fail you a successor on the throne of Israel.'	<b>D6.5:</b> You shall love YHWH your God <b>with all your heart, and with all your being</b> , and with all your might.
