

## “Filled with the Holy Spirit” in Acts

2.4	All of them were <b>filled with the Holy Spirit</b> and <u>began to speak in other languages</u> , as the Spirit gave them ability.
4.8-10	Then Peter, <b>filled with the Holy Spirit</b> , said to them, " <u>Rulers of the people and elders</u> , if we are questioned today because of a good deed done to someone who was sick and are asked how this man has been healed, let it be known to all of you, and to all the people of Israel, that this man is standing before you in good health by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead.
4.31	When they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken; and they were all <b>filled with the Holy Spirit</b> and <u>spoke the word of God with boldness</u> .
7.58	But <b>filled with the Holy Spirit</b> , [Stephen] gazed into heaven and <u>saw the glory of God and Jesus standing at the right hand of God</u> .
9.17-18	So Ananias went and entered the house. He laid his hands on Saul and said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on your way here, has sent me so that you may regain your sight and be <b>filled with the Holy Spirit</b> ." And immediately <u>something like scales fell from his eyes, and his sight was restored</u> . Then he got up and was baptized,
13.9-10	But Saul, also known as Paul, <b>filled with the Holy Spirit</b> , <u>looked intently at him and said</u> , "You son of the devil, you enemy of all righteousness, full of all deceit and villainy, will you not stop making crooked the straight paths of the Lord?"
