

Joab, in service to David in 2 Samuel

Chapter(s) 2-3	With David king in Hebron over Judah, Joab and Abner and twelve each of their slaves meet at the pool of Gibeon, when all their slaves died. In the aftermath, Abner kills Joab's brother, Asahel. Joab murders Abner in blood vengeance.
Chapter(s) 10	Joab leads David's army in battle against the Arameans and Ammonites.
Chapter(s) 11	With the Ammonite war waging, Joab serves David's desire to cover up his affair with Bathsheba, woman of Uriah, but having Uriah killed.
Chapter(s) 14	Joab perceives that David's mind is on Absalom and gets a woman of Tekoa to come pose as a widow to get David back on track.
Chapter(s) 18-19	Joab leads the battle against the forces of Absalom and kills David's rebel son. After, he rouses the mourning king back into action.
Chapter(s) 20	Joab senses that Absalom's former commander, Amasa, is not really with David, and kills him.
