

Gibeon in the Hebrew Scriptures

[note the related contexts of all the references]

Joshua 9-10; 11.19	[The Gibeonites, afraid of Joshua/Israel, make a covenant with Joshua to become slaves; Joshua protects them from a coalition of local kings: "There was not a town that made peace with the Israelites, except the Hivites, the inhabitants of Gibeon; all were taken in battle."
Joshua 21.17	Now part of "Benjamin," Gibeon is given to the Levites.
2 Samuel 2	Abner and Joab set their slaves against each other at the pool of Gibeon, where they are all killed.
2 Samuel 20.8	Joab kills Amasa at "the large stone that is at Gibeon"
1 Kings 3.4-5	Solomon offers sacrifices at the "high place" at Gibeon; YHWH appears to Solomon in a dream there
1 Kings 9.2	YHWH again appears to Solomon "as he had appeared to him at Gibeon"
Isaiah 28.21	"YHWH will rise up as on Mount Perazim, he will rage as in the valley of Gibeon; to do his deed--strange is his deed! and to work his work--alien is his work!"
Jeremiah 28.1-3	In that same year, at the beginning of the reign of King Zedekiah of Judah, in the fifth month of the fourth year, the prophet Hananiah son of Azzur, from Gibeon, spoke to me in the house of YHWH, in the presence of the priests and all the people, saying, "Thus says YHWH of hosts, the God of Israel: I have broken the yoke of the king of Babylon. Within two years I will bring back to this place all the vessels of the Lord's house, which King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon took away from this place and carried to Babylon.
Jeremiah 41.11-16	[A military confrontation at the pool of Gibeon]
Nehemiah 3.7	repairs [to the Jerusalem wall] were made by Melatiah the Gibeonite and Jadon the Meronothite--the men of Gibeon and of Mizpah--who were under the jurisdiction of the governor of the province Beyond the River.
