

Tyre in the Bible (examples)

2 Samuel 5.11	King Hiram of Tyre sent messengers to David , along with cedar trees, and carpenters and masons who built David a house.
2 Samuel 24.7	[the census takers] and came to the fortress of Tyre and to all the cities of the Hivites and Canaanites; and they went out to the Negeb of Judah at Beer-sheba.
1 Kings 5, 7.13-14; 9.11- 12 [parallels in 1 Chronicles 14.1; 2 Chronicles 2.3, 11]	Now King Hiram of Tyre sent his servants to Solomon , when he heard that they had anointed him king in place of his father; for Hiram had always been a friend to David....Now King Solomon invited and received Hiram from Tyre. He was the son of a widow of the tribe of Naphtali, whose father, a man of Tyre, had been an artisan in bronze; he was full of skill, intelligence, and knowledge in working bronze. He came to King Solomon, and did all his work....King Hiram of Tyre having supplied Solomon with cedar and cypress timber and gold, as much as he desired, King Solomon gave to Hiram twenty cities in the land of Galilee. But when Hiram came from Tyre to see the cities that Solomon had given him, they did not please him.
Psalm 45.12- 13a	the people of Tyre will seek [the king's] favor with gifts , the richest of the people with all kinds of wealth.
Isaiah 23	[vv. 1-2] The oracle concerning Tyre. Wail, O ships of Tarshish, for your fortress is destroyed.
Ezekiel 26	[vv.2-4] Mortal, because Tyre said concerning Jerusalem, "Aha, broken is the gateway of the peoples; it has swung open to me; I shall be replenished, now that it is wasted." Therefore, thus says the Lord YHWH: See, I am against you, O Tyre! I will hurl many nations against you , as the sea hurls its waves. They shall destroy the walls of Tyre and break down its towers. I will scrape its soil from it and make it a bare rock.
Ezekiel 27	[vv. 2-3, 27] Now you, mortal, raise a lamentation over Tyre , and say to Tyre, which sits at the entrance to the sea, merchant of the peoples on many coastlands, Thus says the Lord YHWH: O Tyre, you have said, "I am perfect in beauty"... Your riches, your wares, your merchandise, your mariners and your pilots, your caulkers, your dealers in merchandise, and all your warriors within you, with all the company that is with you, sink into the heart of the seas on the day of your ruin.
Ezekiel 28	[v. 2] Mortal, say to the prince of Tyre , Thus says the Lord YHWH: Because your heart is proud and you have said, "I am a god; I sit in the seat of the gods, in the heart of the seas," yet you are but a mortal , and no god, though you compare your mind with the mind of a god.
Amos 1.9-10	Thus says YHWH: For three transgressions of Tyre, and for four , I will not revoke the punishment; because they delivered entire communities over to Edom, and did not remember the covenant of kinship. So I will send a fire on the wall of Tyre, fire that shall devour its strongholds.
Matthew 11.21-22	"Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the deeds of power done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes. But I tell you, on the day of judgment it will be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon than for you.
