

Acts 11.27-12.25 chiasm

A 11.27-30: the famine: Saul and Barnabas sent to Judea with *diakonian* (famine relief)

B 12.1-4: Herod murders James (brother of John) to distract from the famine, putting Peter in prison

C 12.5-17: Peter is rescued from the prison by an angel who “strikes” him

B' 12.18-19: Herod murders the guards

A' 12.20-25: Herod responds to the Tyrians and Sidonians need for food during the famine and dies after being “struck”; Barnabas and Saul go to Jerusalem with *diakonian* (famine relief)
