

“Salvation” (*sōteria*) in Luke-Acts

LUKE	
1.69	“He has raised up a horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David”
1.71	“ salvation from our enemies and from the hand of all who hate us.”
1.77	“to give knowledge of salvation to his people by the forgiveness of their sins.”
19.9	Then Jesus said to him, “Today salvation has come to this house, because he too is a son of Abraham.
ACTS	
4.12	“There is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among mortals by which we must be saved.”
7.25	“[Moses] thought his brothers would understand that God through his hand was giving salvation to them, but they did not understand.”
13.26	“My brothers, you descendants of Abraham's family, and others who fear God, to us the word of this salvation has been sent.”
13.47	“For so the Lord has commanded us, saying, ‘I have set you to be a light for the nations, so that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth.’”
16.17, 21	While she followed Paul and us, she would cry out, “These men are slaves of the Most High God, who proclaim to you a way of salvation ...not lawful for us as Romans to adopt or observe.”
27.34	“Therefore I urge you to take some food, for it will assure your salvation ; for none of you will lose a hair from your heads.”
