

“the Word” in Acts 13-14

13.5	When they arrived at Salamis, <u>they proclaimed</u> the word of God in the synagogues of the Judeans.
13.7	He was with the proconsul, Sergius Paulus, an intelligent man, who summoned Barnabas and Saul and wanted <u>to hear</u> the word of God .
13.15	After the reading of the law and the prophets, the officials of the synagogue sent them a message, saying, "Brothers, <u>if you have any</u> word of exhortation for the people, give it."
13.44	The next sabbath almost the whole city [of Pisidian Antioch] gathered <u>to hear</u> the word of the Lord .
13.26	brothers, you descendants of Abraham's family, and others who fear God, to us the word of this salvation <u>has been sent</u> .
13.46	Then both Paul and Barnabas spoke out boldly, saying, "It was necessary that the word of God <u>should be spoken first to you</u> . Since you reject it and judge yourselves to be unworthy of eternal life, we are now turning to the nations.
13.48-49	When the nations heard this, they were glad and <u>praised</u> the word of the Lord ; and as many as had been destined for eternal life became believers. Thus the word of the Lord <u>spread throughout the region</u> .
14.3	So they remained for a long time, speaking boldly for the Lord, who <u>testified to the</u> word of his grace by granting signs and wonders to be done through them.
14.12	Barnabas they called Zeus, and Paul they called Hermes, because he was the <u>leader of</u> the word .
14.25	When <u>they had spoken</u> the word in Perga, they went down to Atalia.
