

"Judeans and Greeks" in Acts

14.1	The same thing occurred in Iconium, where Paul and Barnabas went into the Judean synagogue and spoke in such a way that a great number of both Judeans and Greeks became believers.
18.4	Every sabbath [Paul] would argue in the synagogue [in Corinth] and would try to convince Judeans and Greeks.
19.10	This continued for two years [in Ephesus], so that all the residents of Asia, both Judeans and Greeks, heard the word of the Lord.
19.17	When [the overpowering of the sons of Sceva] became known to all residents of Ephesus, both Judeans and Greeks, everyone was awestruck; and the name of the Lord Jesus was praised.
20.21	"as I [Paul] testified to both Judeans and Greeks about repentance toward God and faith toward our Lord Jesus.
